Redbone Willy's Gypsy Farm Fair

GENERAL INFORMATION

Date: Saturday, October 11, 2025, from 10am-5pm

Location: The fair is on the same property as Redbone Willys Trading Co. All vendors will be located directly behind the store in and around the DeStarté venue. Customer and vendor parking will be at 158 Poe Road, which is the open field leading to the venue. Redbone Willys and the DeStarté vendue are owned by Glenda Miller and is an 8th generation ancestor of the 88-acre bi-centennial farm known as the Bingham Homestead.

Set Up: Our goal is to have all 125 spaces assigned and arranged 30 days prior to the event. We aim for 10-15 food trucks and 110-115 artisan vendors. All vendors are vetted for high quality and must have a social media presence. The venue will be divided into 5-6 zones. Regardless of the tent site, each vendor should have at least 5-10 feet of free space on all sides. We offer early event set up on

- Thursday, October 9th from 10am-7pm
- Friday October 10th from 8am-7pm (*mandatory*)
- Saturday, October 11th from 7-8:30am

The entry gate for vendors will close at 8:30am

Artisan vendors who are not completely set up by 7pm Friday will not be allowed to transport items to their space by vehicle on Saturday and will need to manually carry the items to their space. Food trucks are encouraged to set up early as well, but if not, all spaces will be first come first serve on Saturday. Reserved spaces cannot be guaranteed. Late arrivals, after 9am, cannot be guaranteed a premier space.

Additional Amenities: 2-3 music stages featuring local performers all day, restrooms throughout the property and free parking.
